Enclosed are three copies of a manuscript entitled

Nucleate Boiling--The Relationship Between Heat
Flux and Thermal Driving Force by Eugene

The above is a revision of a manuscript I submitted earlier and the revisions are intended to bring it into line with the adverse reviews it received at that time.

I think you will agree that the enclosed manuscript leaves no doubt as to the nature of the subject relationship. The revised version is perhaps less tactful than the original. However, I seriously doubt that either version would make any friends for me. It is perhaps fortunate that I agree with Thomas Hart Benton:

My friends--and in that term I comprehend those who come to hear the truth and believe it--none others.

In all fairness, I should tell you that I reread the original version and I quite agree that it could not be published as it was. I think it would make a good lecture, but it would hardly stand up as a published manuscript.

If you do read the enclosed manuscript, I would be much more interested in your reaction than in Rohsenow's.
