

Dear Adiutori:

I refer to your letter of April 30 which I can answer quickly by saying that I would be willing to receive from you two or three additional manuscripts at the same time. I do want to make clear, however, that this does not insure that I will take them into consideration and send them out for review. I must look them over first, as I do all papers which come to me. In your particular case, I am going to watch for exaggerated statements which I have criticized before, because such statements make the reviewers angry and immediately prejudiced against what you may have to say. Therefore, I caution you to be very careful. If they seem satisfactory in this regard and are of possible interest to Journal readers I will take them into consideration and send them out for review.

I have received a carbon copy of Professor Rohsenow's letter to you of April 27. I would like to emphasize that he criticizes your writing style and method of presentation as I have done. It cannot be emphasized too much that you weaken your own case by such writing. I also note that Rohsenow charges you with the selection of data which selection was not complete. I hope that you will be extremely careful on this point, because it is the charge that you have been making against some others in this field. You must be very careful about this.
