In answer to your letter of February 15, I would be pleased to publish a ''popularized'' version of your paper, ''A New Look at the Origin of the Heat Transfer Coefficient Concept.'' The revised article would fit very nicely into our August issue, which has heat transfer as one of its themes.

To meet the deadline for the August issue, I will need your revisions by June 1. The paper is very readable in its present form. I would suggest summarizing and compressing the sections on Newton's Law of Cooling as Described in Physics Texts and Heat Transfer Texts to eliminate as many references to textbooks as possible within these sections. (The references elsewhere to the works of Adiutori, Grattan-Guinness, Herival, and Maxwell are worth preserving.) As you know, the detailed literature review that is essential for a scholarly paper is less appropriate in a magazine article.

If you are pressed for time, we would be happy to make these editorial changes and show them to you for your approval before publication.

I regret not being able to answer your letter sooner, but the backlog of unsolicited manuscripts is quite large and I try to read each one before responding. I look forward to hearing from you soon.
