Dear Mr. Adiutori:

Thank you for your letter dated May 21 in which you offer to give some lectures at the end of our summer course on two-phase flow.

I would welcome some interaction with you because I feel sure that this would be to our mutual benefit. However I have up to now strongly resisted the idea of having lectures given by anyone other than the three men mentioned in the brochure. We have gone to a great deal of trouble to produce some 1100 pages of notes which fit together into a consistent and logical sequence. My experience with multi-lecturer courses is that they are rather like conferences and the students have great trouble getting oriented to the variety of presentations.

There is a possibility that we could fit you in as a "special topic" on the final day of the course. Before deciding one way or another I will need to consult with Collier and Zuber about the amount of time which they may be able to give up to make room for you.
